Acquire a dedication brick for Circus World's "Ring of Honor!" Not only will you support circus heritage but you'll become a permanent part of historic Ringlingville!

Following the 2008 flood, State and Federal resources allowed us to begin making repairs and improvements to Circus World's grounds and buildings. One such project is the redesigned Ringlingville courtyard. Once used as the main entrance to Circus World, the badly damaged asphalt has been transformed into a wonderful green space with concrete walkways and colorful maple trees. At the heart of the space is a 20-foot ring encircling a granite marker proclaiming the National Landmark status of the Ringling brothers winter quarters. Flying proudly above the marker are the National and State flags; all surrounded by shrubbery and flowers in vibrant colors.



A major component of the courtyard improvement project will be laying the ring of personalized bricks around the perimeter of the flagpole and Ringlingville monument.

We would like to make our cherished friends and donors a lasting piece of this beautiful space; recognizing their substantial contributions to Circus World. We are offering an opportunity to obtain a 4"x 8" or 8"x 8" personalized brick that will be laid in a circle, on the outside perimeter of the Ringlingville marker. This circle will be known as the "Ring of Honor" and these terracotta-hued, personalized bricks will become an enduring symbol of your devotion to the heritage and preservation of the American circus!

Authentic reproductions of cast iron tables and chairs from the Ringling era are now made from cast aluminum for beauty and durability. An inscribed plaque will memorialize the donor. The set will be placed on the main walkway between the Irvin Feld Exhibit Hall & Visitor Center and the Ringlingville monument.



Cast aluminum benches with inscribed plaques will surround the "Ring of Honor." The benches with their exquisite detail, are the perfect place to sit and dream about the days when circus wagons and exotic animals were common sights on the property.
